Pre-season – ARES members and leadership

- ✓ Create kit lists for both stay and deploy
- Develop three family emergency plans: (see FEMA and Red Cross websites for guidance)
 - You operating at home with family
 - o Family at home, you deployed
 - Family evacuated, you deployed
- ✓ Create a plan to harden your home against damage, especially in storm-prone areas
 - o Make sure you have needed supplies and tools to implement the hardening plan
 - Don't raid storm supplies for other projects
 - o Educate family members on the hardening plan, and teach any needed skills
- ✓ Make a home-preparedness list or kit
 - o Non-perishable food, bottled water, sanitation supplies
 - o Grab-and-go evacuation bags with clothes, contact lists, medications, essentials
- ✓ Test generator or other backup power systems
- ✓ Refresh/top off generator fuel stock
- ✓ Live-test portable stations for all critical functions
 - o If using NBEMS or Winlink, test them on-air
 - Load-test rechargeable batteries
- ✓ Make sure printed copies of ARES Operations Plans are up to date

Pre-storm - ARES members

- ✓ Review emergency plans with family and determine your availability
- ✓ Talk to your EC to determine where you're likely to be needed
- ✓ Check go-kits for completeness, replace out of date supplies
- ✓ Test generator or other backup power systems
- ✓ Check generator fuel supply
- ✓ Load vehicles
- ✓ Fill vehicle fuel tank(s)
- ✓ Consider dropping wire antennas to the ground until the storm passes

Pre-storm - ARES Leadership

All of the above, plus:

- ✓ Review plans with key served-agency staff yours and theirs
- ✓ Poll both active and reserve members for possible availability
- ✓ Make tentative assignments two members per task or site (in case one becomes unavailable)
- ✓ Create tentative 72-hour staffing plan based on above
- ✓ Discuss potential ARESMAT needs with Section staff, ARRL HQ
- ✓ Pre-position equipment at key agency locations
- ✓ Test all permanently-installed agency stations & backup power, locate any spare equipment
